Dear Colleagues,

Let me first apologise for the delay in bringing about June, 2018 issue of JILA, for certain circumstances beyond our control. As you might be aware, that JILA is now a peer reviewed journal in real sense of the term, the articles submitted are first subjected to checking of permissible percentage of plagiarism and then edited at two levels. The first preliminary editing leads to signing of the Copyright Transfer Agreement by the author(s). After that, each article is rigorously edited by the chief editor, as to its subject dealt in and the language used. The articles selected finally for a given issue are formatted by the Manager, JILA as per International Standards, before it is sent to the printer. The journal appears in the UGC's approved list available on its site.

The present issue is comprised of five articles, first of which entitled 'Knowledge Management System: Relevance in Social Sciences' is based on the Ph.D. thesis, being submitted by Mr. Rumman Gul under my supervision. The title of his Ph.D. / the present article is being dealt with for the first time in the relevant literature of the subject. The article by Garg and Pooja is a Bibliometric Study conducted on the 'Ph.D. theses accepted by Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) in the discipline of Chemistry during the period from 1935 to 2014. The next article by Amanulla is a Case Study of the New College Library with regard to its Collection Development issues from 2009 to 2013. All the five articles are well written and expected to widen the scope of the subjects dealt with.
