• **IGNCA introduces Five PG Diploma Courses and 6 new Certificate Courses**

Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts (IGNCA), an autonomous institution under the Union Ministry of Culture, Government of India, has decided to introduce five diploma courses and six new Certificate Courses in art, culture and related subjects. The main aim of these courses is to create arts and culture with all its dimensions to design and develop content exploration system and to intensify culture learning and visualization.

In order to attract the people towards Indian art and to nurture trained manpower in the related fields, five 1 year Post Graduate Diploma evening courses have been introduced in the academic year 2018-19. The details of these courses are:-

1. PG Diploma in Cultural Informatics
2. PG Diploma in Preventive Conservation
3. PG Diploma in Buddhist Studies
4. PG Diploma in Digital Library and Data Management
5. PG Diploma in Manuscriptology and Paleography

Additionally, 6 new Certificate Courses will be introducing shortly by IGNCA:

1. Academic Integrity and Research Ethics
2. Open Access for Library and Information Science Professionals
3. Open Access for Researchers

• **Universities in Germany and Sweden Lose Access to Elsevier Journals**

In Germany and Sweden approximately 300 academic institutions lost access to new papers published in Elsevier journals in the month of July due to a standstill in negotiations for nationwide subscription contracts. Academics are trying to find alternative means for obtaining Elsevier's papers such as using inter-library loan services, emailing authors, finding earlier versions on preprint servers, or buying individual papers.

In the two countries, academic library consortia are pushing for a so-called publish-and-read model, which combines publishing articles as open access and reading paywalled articles into one fee.

• **Universities Working to make library Metadata Searchable on the Web**

Academic libraries have been using their own standards for the communication of metadata about resources in their catalogs since 1960s. MARC (Machine-readable cataloging), which was originally designed for magnetic tape-based computers, standards is only understood by library systems. Libraries have isolated from the broader world of information developing there because of the failure to speak the web language.

Stanford Libraries are working with the libraries of Cornell, Harvard and the University of Iowa to continue the development of a "linked data" metadata environment and to take the advantage of the semantic web. Stanford is also collaborating with the Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC) and the Library of Congress to expand the number of libraries implementing linked data. A cloud-based sandbox environment that will allow the community to access, adopt and implement linked data is developing by Stanford.

The grant team also will focus on the creation of open source tools and policies to be adopted across the academic library community for transitioning to and implementing linked data.

There are many policy decisions to be worked through in the transition. In the environment we have now, the data is contained and we can stamp it with an award of quality and everyone knows what it means.

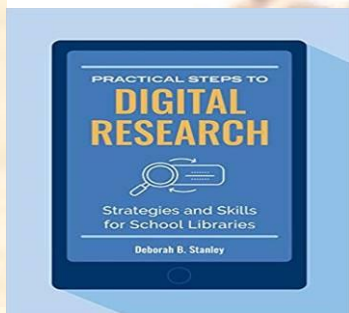

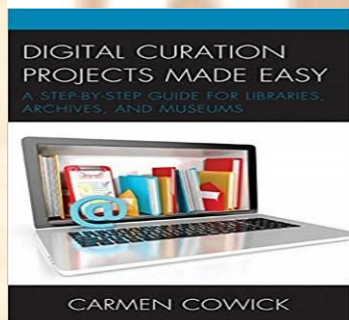

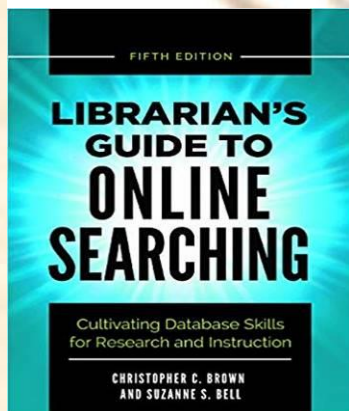
